

August 6th Todd Herendeen Band Johnny Cash Tribute



aitlyn Baker's music reflects the beauty of the Cumberland Mountains and the ruggedness of the coal mining culture in which she was raised. With influences as diverse as Elvis, Loretta and the Beatles, Kaitlyn's style is traditional country with tinges of rock, blues, bluegrass and gospel. The 22-year-old singer/songwriter bases many of her songs on real experiences. Her fiery composition "Burn" was inspired by something that happened to her grandmother, as a young woman. The heartbreaking ballad "To Pieces" was written following a breakup. "Coal Train", which was inspired by the declining coal industry, was included in the 2015 ACM Awards ZinePak, alongside tracks by Blake Shelton, Miranda Lambert, Luke Bryan and other superstars. "Heart of Appalachia," meantime, has been described as a love song to Baker's native Southwest Virgina, and is now the area's official theme song for tourism. Kaitlyn has opened for such artists as Travis Tritt, Chase Bryant, Billy Currington, Rhonda Vincent and others. She has performed coast to coast and appeared on the nationally syndicated television concert series "Song of the Mountains." 




